

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009 -106**

**WHEREAS**, the Assessor of the Township of Aberdeen has submitted a request for the exemption from residential property taxes for the property known as 19 Oakshades Avenue also known as Block 275 Lot 8 on the official tax map of the Township of Aberdeen, as well as a request to the Monmouth County Board of taxation for relief from all property taxes as of October 1, 2009; **and**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to J.S.S.A. 54:4-3.30, the State of New Jersey provides an exemption from residential property taxes for a United States Veteran who has suffered permanent disabling injuries while in combat; **and**

**WHEREAS**, this exemption is also extended to the surviving spouse of such a veteran for so long as the surviving spouse is the owner of and resident in the property in question, during the length of the surviving spouse's widowhood or widower hood, including such instances where the death of the veteran occurred prior to January 10, 1972, the effective date of this law; **and**

**WHEREAS**, such information has been submitted to the Assessor on behalf of Robert E. Reingle, who suffered permanent disabling injuries while serving in the United States Armed Forces during the Vietnam Conflict.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey, that relief from payment of property taxes as of October 1, 2009 is hereby approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Township Council hereby endorses the requested exemption from residential property for Block 275 Lot 8 for as long as Robert E. Reingle remains eligible for this exception pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30
